AND INFORMATION SOCIETY DAY: Communications Museum is going to participate in “The Museum Fair of Macao, Hong Kong and Guangdong Province 2010” with the theme of “Museums for Social Harmony” at the Tap Seac Square on May 9. Macao Post will issue a commemorative envelope for free distribution to the public and provide commemorative cancellation service for stamp collectors at the Temporary Postal Counter from 2:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

During the event, visitors can play the interactive games “*Smart postman – land, sea, air*” and “*How to put the stamp chop?*” at the booth of Communications Museum. There will also be live demonstrations of the *Van de Graaff Generator* and its mini version so that visitors can experience the effects of static electricity. Visitors will not only learn more about postal / philatelic service from the games, but they may also win souvenirs and free admission coupons of the Museum.

To celebrate the “World Telecommunications and Information Society Day” and “International Museum Day”, visitors can enjoy free entrance at the Communications Museum on May 15, 16 & 18 (Saturday, Sunday & Tuesday).
